**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
CHAPTER 3 OF TITLE 9 OF THE PLANO CITY CODE ENTITLED
“FIREWORKS”
BY AMENDING SECTION 9-3-7-A-C ENTITLED
“Possession of Fireworks”**

WHEREAS, the City Council has heretofore adopted Ordinance 2014-_____ regulating the possession and use of Fireworks within the City of Plano, which Ordinance is codified in the Plano City Code at Chapter 3 of Title 9 of the Plano City Code; and

WHEREAS, after study and investigation, the City Council has determined that it is necessary and desirable and in the public interest to further regulate the possession of Fireworks and to amend Section 9-3-7-A-C of the Plano City Code as hereinafter set forth:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLANO, KENDALL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 9-3-7-A-C of the Plano City Code is amended in its entirety in words and figures as follows:

“9-3-7-A-C:

(a) Possession of Fireworks: It shall be unlawful for any person to possess or to discharge anywhere in the city any 1.3G fireworks, consumer fireworks, or display fireworks. It shall be noted that some 1.4G fireworks are acceptable if the appropriate criteria is met by those in possession of the fireworks.

(b) For purposes of enforcing this Chapter, evidence of fireworks paraphernalia or other fireworks related debris which is found on the property shall be conclusive evidence that the activities set forth in this Chapter have occurred and the property owner and/or lessee of such property shall be deemed responsible for such activities and may be subject to the penalties set forth in this Chapter.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
